


eSchool Expectations

eSchool is a classroom setting. You must act and behave as if you were sitting in a real classroom. All of your teachers and classmates can see what you are doing when you are online.

<p>Respectful</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students are using appropriate language with other students and staff.• Students show respect to one another and staff by participating in and adding to virtual discussions.
<p>On Task and Ready to Learn</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students are sitting up.• Students have their camera turned on and are in front of the camera.• Students are engaged in the lesson without changing camera settings, backgrounds, or other off task activities.• If students are released to break out rooms for independent work or small group activities, cameras are on and students are engaged in the task given by the teacher.
<p>Always Safe</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students return to class after specials, breaks, and lunch within five minutes.• Students have their real name listed on the Zoom application, so teachers know who is asking to enter the Zoom room.
<p>Responsible</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students log in for Zoom live instruction and attendance at 8:00 AM each day.• Students are dressed and ready to participate in learning at 8:00 AM each day.• Students submit work to teachers in a timely manner.
